

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



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- Please dress your child in the Mater Dei Pre-K uniform and SNEAKERS everyday!
 - Fall/Summer: Light blue t-shirt with the Mater Dei logo. Navy blue shorts or skorts for the girls. o White or black socks covering the ankle with sneakers.
 - Winter: Light blue t-shirts with logo with a navy blue sweatshirt with logo. Navy blue sweatpants or leggings for girls.
 - (Sweatshirts and T-Shirts are purchased at Mater Dei Catholic School. Parents are welcome to purchase navy blue shorts, sweatpants, skorts, or leggings wherever you shop.) Children are permitted to wear a white long-sleeve shirt under the t-shirt if it is cold, but not cold enough for the sweatshirt.
 - Parents are welcome to call the president with any additional questions.
- Please label jackets, coats, sweatshirts, and winter gear with child's name or initials.



FOLDERS



- All written communication such as change of transportation can be sent to school in the blue folders
- Please send your child's blue communication folder with them to school in their school bags each day.
- It is important to check and empty your child's folder everyday so that you do not miss important information and beautiful artwork that they have created.
- We use a lot of our artwork to decorate our classroom and bulletin boards so you will most likely receive multiple art pieces in your child's folder after we are done displaying them.

Dismissal

- Arrival and Dismissal Procedures for Pre K3 and Pre K4
 - Arrival time is between 8:00-8:30
 - Pre-K4 students and their siblings may be dropped off at the gym ramp doors. Cars will enter the property off Third Street and proceed to the Ramp Door by the gym. Faculty and staff will escort the children to the classrooms.
 - Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 students will dismiss out of the front door at noon dismissal.
 - Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 students will follow the same procedure for dismissal as outlined in the arrival procedure for end of day dismissal.
 - Dismissal begins at 3:00
 - Siblings K-8th will be dismissed at 3:20pm.
