Pref Arrival and Dismissal Procedures ••• NEW FOR 2023-2024

Please Note: New PreK 3 and 4 Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

Due to the addition of two PreK classes, the arrival and dismissal procedures
for PreK students will be as follows:

Arrival and Dismissal:

- PreK 3 students will use the front driveway. Parents will enter the property off Lansdale Avenue and circle around to the Main Entrance. Faculty and staff will escort the children to their classrooms.
- PreK 4 students will enter the property off Third Street. Parents will drive through the schoolyard in single file and follow the direction of Mater Dei staff. Faculty and staff will escort the children to their classrooms.



Matters will be posted on the MD website and emailed to families on August 21, 2023. The *Mater Dei Handbook* contains information on the academic life of the school as well as policies and procedures. *Mater Dei Matters* provides information regarding the most frequently asked questions about all that "matters" at Mater Dei so families can quickly access day-to-day information about our school. After reading the Mater Dei Handbook, all families are asked to sign the Handbook and Authorizations Agreement Form on the Mater Dei website by Thursday, August 31, 2023.

Hair Regulations for all students in Pre-K through Grade 8:

- Hair should be neat, clean, and trimmed.
- Boys' hair needs to be in a traditional cut, kept to the top of the neck, above the collar, off the ears, and from mid-forehead to above the eyebrows. Fad or extreme hairstyles, including ponytails and buns, are not permitted.
- Girls' hair must be off their faces. A simple bow or headband is acceptable.
- All hair should be a natural color.



PreK 3 and PreK 4 Uniform – New for 2023-2024

The Mater Dei Class of 2033 and Class of 2034 will wear a light blue t-shirt and a navy blue sweatshirt with either navy blue shorts, navy blue skorts, navy blue sweatpants, or navy blue leggings. Mater Dei Catholic School will provide two t-shirts for all students registered in Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4. Parents are welcome to purchase navy blue shorts, skorts, leggings, and sweatpants wherever you shop. Families will have the option to purchase the sweatshirt and additional t-shirts through school in September. Please be sure to look for the details for ordering the sweatshirt and additional t-shirts in the very near future. We are looking forward to this new look for our youngest MD students.
